Assignment 1: Sing and Dance

Due February 8, 2010

The first assignment asks you to write a program to make your robot sing (well, beep!) and dance. You should write a dance routine (a function named `dance()`). Your Python program should include the following components:

1. An effectively commented program, including your name, the date, email and explanations of any complicated code. For example, the first couple of lines should look like

2. Take some input from the user (using the `raw_input` function) to determine the dance behavior (e.g. length, number of steps, tempo, key).
3. Use a looping construct (`for` or `while` loops).

- How to write functions.
- How to use loops.
- How to get input from the user.
- How to properly document a program.
